As the President (Executive Officer) or Secretary of the Association I certify, under penalties of perjury and falsification found in 18 Pa. C.S.A. §4901 et seq. that:

- a. No person under the age of 18 will be permitted by the association to play bingo unless accompanied by an adult.
- b. The facility in which any game of bingo is to be played does have adequate means of ingress and egress and adequate sanitary facilities available in the area.
- c. The association is the sole or joint owner with a licensed association of the equipment used in playing bingo or it leases the equipment from another licensed association under a written agreement for a fee which is not determined by the amount of receipts realized from the playing of bingo or the number of people attending bingo games. This paragraph shall not apply to associations contracting with charitable associations or outside operators to conduct bingo at expositions, carnivals or fairs.
- d. The association is the owner of both the premises upon which bingo is played and the personal property used in the conduct of the game or, if it is not, that the association is not leasing such premises or personal property from the owner thereof under an oral agreement, nor is it leasing such premises or personal property from the owner thereof under a written agreement at a rental which is determined by either the amount of receipts realized from the playing of bingo or the number of people attending bingo games, nor is it leasing such premises or personal property from a person who has been convicted of a felony or a violation of this act.
- e. The association will not conduct the playing of bingo more than twice per week in any one week, except those associations conducting bingo at expositions, carnivals or fairs not exceeding ten days in duration.
- f. The association in any calendar day will not award a total of more than \$4,000 in prizes.
- g. The association is a nonprofit association as defined in this act.

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE APPLICATION (use 8 1/2 " x 11" sheets where possible).

1. A copy of the current bylaws of the association and if not expressly explained therein, a written statement by the association's President or Secretary indicating the requirements for obtaining membership in the association.
2. A copy of the association's Articles of Incorporation if incorporated.
3. A copy of the deed for the premises where Bingo is played if owned by the association, or if the premise is rented or leased, a copy of the signed, dated rental or lease agreement.
4. A copy of the original bill of sale for the bingo gaming equipment if owned by the association along with an affidavit from the President or Treasurer of the association, that the association has paid the full purchase price shown on the bill of sale or receipt. If the bingo gaming equipment is rented or leased, a copy of the signed, dated rental or lease agreement.
5. The name of the financial institution and the account number for the association bingo account into which the proceeds of each day's games will be deposited prior to distribution. If this is a renewal application, a copy of all deposits into the account for the preceding year must be provided.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FOR BINGO LICENSE

Questions regarding the game of bingo and this application should be referred to the Licensing Authority annotated at the top of page one of this application.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

BLOCK 1 - Applicant shall check appropriate block to indicate the type of application that the association is submitting.

If applying for a special permit for entertainment purposes the application, in addition to the documentation listed on page 2, must be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the executive officer or secretary of the association attesting that:

(1) The association is a nonprofit community recognized association.

(2) No person under the age of 18 will be permitted by the association to play bingo unless accompanied by an adult.

(3) The association is conducting bingo for entertainment purposes only and all prizes awarded will be of nominal value.

BLOCK 2 - Enclose check, cashier's check or money order for the applicable fee, payable to the Licensing Authority.

BLOCKS 3-12 -Enter specific information regarding the association. Enter in Item 5 the type of association applying for license; e.g. Charitable, Civic and Service Associations, Sportsman's and Wildlife Associations, Bona Fide Senior Citizens Associations, Clubs under Liquor Code 102, School Booster Associations, Fraternal and Veteran's associations.

BLOCK 13 -The Executive Officer or Secretary of the Association must certify statements **a.** through **g.** by completing the personal data at the end of Block 13 and by signing the application.

BLOCK 14 -The Application **MUST** be notarized.

DOCUMENTS LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF PAGE TWO OF THE APPLICATION MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION WHEN APPLYING FOR A LICENSE FOR THE FIRST TIME OR IF THERE HAS BEEN A LAPSE IN LICENSING.
