AS THE COUNTY OF LANCASTER'S DESIGNATED RECIPIENT
OF STATE ETHICS COMMISSION STATEMENTS OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS**

On motion of Commissioner Lehman, seconded by Commissioner Stuckey;

WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania requires the filing of a Statement of Financial Interests by certain candidates, nominees, public officials, public employees and solicitors; and

WHEREAS, The County of Lancaster is statutorily required to receive and retain Statements of Financial Interests filed by individuals; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioners desire to appoint the Chief Clerk of the Board of Elections to receive all Statements of Financial Interests that are filed with the County of Lancaster.



1. The Chief Clerk of the Board of Elections of Lancaster County is hereby designated as the person who is to receive and retain, as required by law, all Statements of Financial Interests filed with the County of Lancaster by any candidates, nominees, public officials, public employees or solicitors.
2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.

Motion passed unanimously.




