Epilepsy Awareness Month

November 2, 2022

WHEREAS, Epilepsy is a neurological condition sometimes referred to as a seizure disorder and is characterized by recurring seizures; and

WHEREAS, 1 in 26 people will develop epilepsy in their lifetime; and

WHEREAS, more than 209,000 Pennsylvanians live with epilepsy or a seizure disorder; and

WHEREAS, Up to 50,000 Americans die each year from seizures and related causes, including Sudden Unexplained Death in Epilepsy (SUDEP); and

WHEREAS, The Epilepsy Foundations in Pennsylvania lead the fight to stop seizures and SUDEP, find a cure and overcome the challenges created by epilepsy through efforts including education, advocacy and research to accelerate ideas into therapies; and

WHEREAS, The Epilepsy Foundations in Pennsylvania are dedicated to ensuring that all people with seizures and epilepsy are able to participate in all life's experiences; and

WHEREAS, Epilepsy Foundation programs provide technical assistance, training and support to Pennsylvania's school nurses, teachers and students on seizure recognition and first aid; and

WHEREAS, statewide Epilepsy Foundation programs provide patient education, public awareness, information and referrals services for children and their families living with seizures in our state; and

WHEREAS, the Epilepsy Foundation Eastern Pennsylvania are celebrating over 40 years of service and dedication to Pennsylvania communities; and


WHEREAS, The prevention and control of epilepsy can be achieved through continued community education and awareness programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, Do hereby proclaim November 2022 as ----- Epilepsy Awareness Month ----- in Lancaster County, and call upon our community to promote awareness and encourage education of epilepsy.
