Update on the 2025 Special and Primary Election

Christa Miller reported that there are 355,842 registered voters in Lancaster County. This is after list maintenance after the 2024 Presidential election. For the 36th District, for the Special Election there are 184,669 voters. Mail-in ballots are at 4,525 and Primary mail-in ballots are at 4,134. L & A will be done next week and programming the week after. Christa stated they are right where they are with all other elections. At next week's Election Board meeting the polling locations changes will be presented. Volunteers are at a good number.
