Commissioner D'Agostino announced an executive session was held at 10:19 a.m. Monday, June 5, 2023, to discuss labor and personnel matters and the Kane case, docket No. 3:23-CV-0059 in the Lancaster County Court of Common Pleas and again at 1:53 p.m. to discuss a labor matter.

Commissioner D'Agostino announced approval of the May 30, 2023 Work Session Minutes.

**Lancaster County Commissioners' Work Session
Tuesday, June 6, 2023**

Commissioner D'Agostino announced that there will be a siren test tomorrow, June 7, 2023 by Constellation Energy, which will conduct a semiannual full volume test of the emergency warning sirens for the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station. The test will begin at approximately 1 p.m. and last about three minutes. The warning siren system consists of 97 sirens within a 10-mile radius around the power station.

1. Ms. Ramos, Executive Director, and Ms. Hatfield, Assistant Director, presented Resolution No. 41 of 2023: Annual Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024.

2. Mr. Pasquale, Director, presented Resolution No. 42 of 2023: Establishing a Ban on Open Burning.

Commissioner Parsons said it is rare that the County does a burn ban but some of the municipalities were interested in having the County do one rather than individual municipalities all doing their own thing. The ban would be for 30 days and can be renewed if needed or lifted. He said there is a significant threat to property, so he is willing to take this step. The main purpose of the ban is to promote awareness that this is a dangerous time to be burning because the conditions are so dry and the intent is not to fine anyone for involuntarily violating the ban.

3. Ms. Adams, District Attorney, Mr. Dreisbach, CEO, and Mr. McCoy, Executive Vice President, presented Resolution No. 42 of 2023: Opioid Request & Agreement with Blueprints for Addiction Recovery

4. Mr. Armer, Buyer III, Mr. Catigano, Buyer I, and Ms. Steberger, Warden, presented a Contract Award with The Act 1 Group, Inc. dba ATIMS.

5. Ms. Natan, Executive Director, presented Renewal Agreements.

6. Mr. Custer, Director of Administration, presented Amended & Renewal Agreements.

7. Mr. Devonshire, Director, presented Change Order #2 with Road-Con, Inc.

8. Mr. Mulligan, Director, presented an ARPA Update.
