Commissioner D'Agostino called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Commissioner D'Agostino announced that the Board of Commissioners met in Executive Session yesterday, Monday, June 12, 2023, at 10:08 a.m. to discuss labor matters, a personnel matter, and an EEOC matter.

Commissioner D'Agostino announced the approval of the June 6, 2023, Work Session Minutes.


1. Mr. Downing, Executive Director, and Mr. Dice, CFO, presented Resolution No. 44 of 2023: Local Match for State Funding.
2. Mr. Pasquale, Director, presented a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) Addendum #5 between Dauphin County and South Central Pennsylvania Counter-Terrorism Task Force (SCTF), and an Agreement with the Governor's Office of Administration.

Commissioner D'Agostino asked for an update on the burn ban. Mr. Pasquale stated they have an inquiry to the Lancaster County Fire Chiefs Association, and the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) State Warden. They are also pulling in data from their rain gauges, as well as the National Weather Service, to assess risk. Mr. Pasquale is expecting an update later this afternoon, and possibly a recommendation for a change as early as tonight.  
The burn ban will be placed on the commissioners' meeting agenda for discussion.

3. Ms. Maounis, Grant Coordinator, presented a Grant Application with the Lancaster Law Foundation.
4. Ms. Pfursich, County Solicitor, presented an Amended Agreement with the County Commissioners Association.
5. June 14, 2023, Commissioners' Meeting Agenda – there will be a Proclamation for Juneteenth.
6. On motion of Commissioner Parsons, seconded by Commissioner Trescot, the meeting was adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
