

Minutes of the
Weekly Meeting of the
Lancaster County Salary Board
July 25, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Ray D'Agostino at 1:30 p.m. in the Human Resources Training Room at the Lancaster County Offices, 150 North Queen Street.

Members Present: Commissioner Ray D'Agostino, Commissioner Joshua Parsons, Commissioner John Trescot, and Deputy Controller Kathy Kunkel.

Not Present: Controller Lisa Colón.

Others Present: Michelle Gallo, Ben Lewis, Larry George, and Jackie Pfursich.

Scott Standish, Planning, requested approval to hire applicant (80699) at an annual salary of \$89,000 which is above the start rate for a Director of Technical Services, Grade E20, effective July 25, 2022. The hourly rate would be \$45.64. The minimum/maximum for this position is \$55,282.50/\$92,157.00. Additionally, the department requests approval for the applicant to accrue 3 weeks of vacation in the first year, 4 weeks of vacation at year 5, and 5 weeks of vacation at year 10. Following discussion, Commissioner Trescot moved. Commissioner Parsons seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Chris Tallarico, Public Defender, requested approval to hire applicant (82199) at an annual salary of \$88,500 which is above the start rate for a Public Defender Manager, Grade E23, effective July 25, 2022. The hourly rate would be \$45.38. The minimum/maximum for this position is \$63,082.50/\$105,144.00. Following discussion, Public Defender Tallarico moved to approve. Commissioner Trescot seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Christa Miller, Voter Registration, requested approval to hire applicant (78928) at an annual salary of \$31,200.00 which is above the start rate for a Clerical Specialist III, Grade N12, effective July 25, 2022. The hourly rate would be \$16.00. The minimum/maximum for this position is \$26,032.50/\$43,407.00. Following discussion, Commissioner Trescot moved to approve. Commissioner Parsons seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Trescot moved to adjourn the meeting at 2:00 p.m. Commissioner Parsons seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
