**Purpose:** To decrease the contract amount because of reduced usage due to COVID and the mass rate change by the Office of Developmental Program.  
  
Aaron's Acres provides in-home & community support, camp & respite school year programs to individuals being served by Lancaster County Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities.  
  
**Amount/Term:** \$40,761.80 for the period July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022.  
  
**Funding:** Budgeted in the Human Services Block Grant.  
This is a decrease of \$12,164.78, 22.98%.
  
2. **Amended Agreement With:** Goodwill Keystone Area  
Harrisburg, PA  
  
**Purpose:** To reduce service lines to actual amount utilized in Fiscal Year 2021-2022.  
  
Goodwill Keystone Area provides supported employment to adults with serious mental illness being served by Lancaster County Mental Health.  
  
**Amount/Term:** \$86,710.72 for the period July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022.  
  
**Funding:** Budgeted in the Social Service Block Grant (Federal) and the Human Services Block Grant.  
Decrease of \$108,569.25, 55.60%.
  
3. **Renewal Agreement With:** Schreiber Center for Pediatric Development  
Lancaster, PA  
  
**Purpose:** To provide camping services to individuals being served by Lancaster County Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities.  
  
**Amount/Term:** \$30,000.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.  
  
**Funding:** Budgeted in the Human Services Block Grant.
  
4. **Renewal Agreement With:** Arch Street Center, Inc.  
Lancaster, PA  
  
**Purpose:** To provide social rehabilitation services in a drop-in center atmosphere for adults who are being served by Lancaster County Mental Health.  
  
**Amount/Term:** \$183,383.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.  
  
**Funding:** Budgeted in the Human Services Block Grant.  
This is a 17.98% decrease from the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 contract.
  
5. **Renewal Agreement With:** Community Services Group, Inc. (CSG)  
Lancaster, PA  
  
**Purpose:** To provide a wide array of community-based services including the vocational day program, supportive employment and job loss prevention, partial hospitalization, social rehabilitation including blended case management services, psychiatric evaluations, medication management, individual therapy

and group therapy to individuals who experience serious mental illness and emotional disturbances.

**Amount/Term:** \$4,611,484.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

**Funding:** Budgeted in the Human Services Block Grant, the Community Mental Health Block Grant (Federal) and Project Assistance to Transition from Homelessness funding (Federal and State).  
This is a decrease of 2.46%, from the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 contract.

6. **Renewal Agreement With:** Keystone Service Systems, Inc.  
Harrisburg, PA

**Purpose:** To provide community residential rehabilitation, supporting housing and supported living services for adults and transitional-age adults with serious mental illness being served by Lancaster County Mental Health.

**Amount/Term:** \$1,830,270.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

**Funding:** Budgeted in the Human Services Block Grant.  
This is a decrease of 0.35%, from the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 contract.

7. **Renewal Agreement With:** The Lodge Life Services  
Lancaster, PA

**Purpose:** To assist adults with serious mental illness who are being served by Lancaster County Mental Health to obtain and maintain independent housing in the community.

**Amount/Term:** \$136,730.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

**Funding:** Budgeted in the Community Mental Health Block Grant (Federal), Housing and Urban Development Funding (Federal) and the Human Services Block Grant.  
This is a decrease of 68.07% from the Fiscal Year 2021-22 contract.

8. **Renewal Agreement With:** Mental Health America of Lancaster County  
Lancaster, PA

**Purpose:** To provide family support/compeer services to individuals being served by Lancaster County Mental Health.

**Amount/Term:** \$273,568.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

**Funding:** Budgeted in the Community Mental Health Services Block Grant (Federal) and the Human Services Block Grant.  
This is an increase of 4.16% from the Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

9. **Renewal Agreement With:** WellSpan Philhaven  
Mount Gretna, PA

**Purpose:** To provide psychiatric outpatient and emergency services for adults and children who experience serious mental illness being served by Lancaster County Mental Health.

**Amount/Term:** \$995,940.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

**Funding:** Budgeted in the Human Services Block Grant.  
This is a decrease of 7.49%, from the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 contract.

**Amount and Terms:**

\$50,000.00 for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

**Funding:**

State - Human Services Block Grant funding. The funding is level from last year.


