*Policy: Ancillary Treatment Services for Pregnant Women
and Women with Children*

I. Purpose:

To establish policy that defines ancillary services and ensures the delivery of those services for pregnant women, women with dependent children, and women attempting to regain custody of their children during their treatment episode.

II. Procedure:

LCDAC and their contracted providers who deliver substance use disorder services to pregnant women, women with dependent children, and women who are seeking custody of their children shall treat the family as a unit, when appropriate, and **provide or arrange for** the provision of the following ancillary services:

- 1) Primary medical care for women, including a referral for prenatal care, as well as childcare while the women are receiving medical care
- 2) Primary pediatric care, including immunization, for their children
- 3) Gender-specific substance use disorder treatment and other therapeutic interventions for women which may address issues of relationships, sexual and physical abuse, and parenting, as well as childcare while the women are receiving these services
- 4) Family therapy, nutrition education, and education to GED level
- 5) Therapeutic interventions for the children in the custody of the women receiving treatment services which may address, among other things, the children's developmental needs, issues of sexual and physical abuse, and neglect
- 6) Case management and transportation to ensure those women and their children have access to the services provided in all items listed above
