**I. Purpose:**

To establish notification procedures to the contracted service providers as well as the DDAP Director of Treatment of any LCDAC funding limitations or any LCDAC funding discontinuation for any services for lack of funding.

**II. Procedure:**

The LCDAC Executive Director will notify DDAP Director of Treatment in writing within five (5) calendar days after LCDAC discontinues or limits authorization of any services for lack of funding.

- The notification written by the LCDAC Executive Director must explain how LCDAC will meet the ongoing treatment needs of the individuals until additional funding is available.
- The notification will be posted on the LCDAC website to inform all contracted service providers.

LCDAC may **not** apply funding limitations to **any** priority Populations.

The LCDAC Executive Director will notify the Treatment Division Director in writing within five (5) calendar days after LCDAC removes the limitations.

- The notification that the removal of the limitations will be posted to the LCDAC website.
