<p>Project/Item Description</p>	<p>The Township will have a fence constructed around the police and public works sides of the building. The sliding gates around the police parking area will secure the vehicles and the building assets. The sliding gates would provide access to police vehicles and employee parking. The design would also allow other agency first responders (police, fire and EMS) access and egress.</p>
<p>Estimated Cost – how cost was derived & provision of partner funds (who is providing, how much and show commitments).</p>	<p>The total cost of the fence and gates is \$162,785 (see estimate). We are seeking \$57,200 to cover the cost of the 2 gates to secure the police side.</p>
<p>Which County ARPA Community-wide Benefit(s) does the project meet?</p>	<p>Infrastructure and public safety</p>
<p>Briefly explain how the project meets the County's guidelines.</p>	<p>The one-time funding request will allow the Township to have gates installed to secure the police portion of the township building. The gates will permit the Township to secure its fleet of marked and unmarked police vehicles, aid in securing the building assets itself (the building generator) and will also allow for a secure location to temporarily store seized vehicles. Additionally, it will establish another barrier in the event a prisoner would escape detention.</p>
<p>Why should this project be a priority and how will it help the County? Also, if this application is for more than one project, please identify each one, provide information and rank them in order of your priority.</p>	<p>As we have seen nationwide, police departments can come under attack at a moment's notice due to events that occur within or outside the effected municipality. These attacks can target buildings and/or vehicles. By creating a physical barrier around our parking area, we can better secure our assets which, in turn, can help us to serve our community. Additionally, the land immediately adjacent to the southern end of our property will be developed into a residential community. This is in addition to the YMCA property that is to the east of the parking lot. The police parking lot sees an abundance of pedestrian and vehicular traffic now, which will increase when the residential neighborhood is developed. This traffic conflicts with our police traffic and unnecessarily puts our community at risk. These gates will block this pedestrian and vehicular traffic.</p>
<p>Will this project require ongoing expense (maintenance, updates) or frequent replacement? Are expenses already being incurred, if so, can they be reduced through this project?</p>	<p>All ongoing maintenance will be provided by the Township</p>
<p>Project Timeline – start to finish, and when funding will be needed.</p>	<p>This project is expected to begin in the summer of 2022, with completion slated for the fall of 2022</p>
<p>Are there other organizations a part of this project? If yes, please list them and their role, including funding. If not, explain why?</p>	<p>The Township will cover the cost of the fence \$105,585 (Total cost \$162,785-\$57,200 for the gates=\$105,585).</p>
