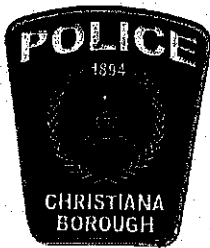

Project Description

Christiana Borough Police Department is applying for \$26,253.72 in Lancaster County ARPA funding to purchase six (6) new Motorola APK 6000 series portable police radios.

Estimated Cost -- how cost was derived and provision of partner funds (who is providing, how much, and show commitments).

The estimated cost of this purchase would be \$29,170.80. Christiana Borough will provide 10% (\$2,917.08) of the cost from General Fund revenues. Please see attached commitment letter from Christiana Borough as well as price quotations for the radios.

This funding request meets the County's Public Safety-Law Enforcement benefit.

This project is consistent with the County and Federal U.S. Treasury guidelines for the use of ARPA funds. The project falls under the Public Safety category as it is equipment for Law Enforcement. This is a one-time purchase with no additional costs needed after purchase. Christiana Borough is prepared to fund 10% of this project with no additional administrative, interest, or other fees or costs with the project

These radios are used to communicate directly with the Lancaster County Wide 911 dispatch Center and with other police officers/departments throughout Lancaster County. This equipment is crucial in our profession as law enforcement officers. They are necessary for day

to day operations as well as the safety of our officers. These radios's will not only help the residents of Christiana Borough, but will assist the County as a whole. They will be used to coordinate police agencies and to communicate with other county public safety agencies during incidents in Christiana Borough and across the County. Most importantly, they are the officer's lifeline if we need to call for help in dangerous situations. Being equipped with functioning portable radios is a necessity in law enforcement.

As you all are aware, in 2013 a new countywide emergency services radio system was deployed. Prior to this our borough purchased all our existing radios so that we were online as soon as the system was operational. After ten years of wear and tear of police life, we are beginning to experience functional issues with our radios. As stated above, it is imperative that our officers have functioning radios with them at all times while on duty or at a major incident. Due to them being purchased at the same time, they will all need to be replaced. However, replacing all of them at the same time would strain our budget.

Will this project require ongoing expense (maintenance, updates) or frequent replacement? Are expenses already incurred, if so, can they be reduced through this project?

The only expected ongoing cost would be the replacement of batteries or repair due to normal wear and tear.

Having new radios would allow us to replace aging radios which require increased maintenance and repair costs.

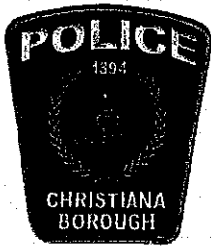

Project Description

Christiana Borough Police Department is applying for \$51,200 in Lancaster County ARPA funding to purchase one new police vehicle that is necessary to replace an existing aging vehicle. The price would include all safety equipment as well as a camera system, computer, and all other equipment necessary for the operation of this vehicle.

Estimated Cost – how cost was derived and provision of partner funds (who is providing, how much, and show commitments).

The estimated cost of this purchase would be approximately \$64,000. Christiana Borough will provide 20% (\$12,800.00) of the cost from General Fund revenues. Please see attached commitment letter from Christiana Borough as well as price quotations for the vehicle and equipment.

Which County ARPA Community-wide Benefit(s) does this project meet?

This funding request meets the County's Public Safety-Law Enforcement benefit.

Briefly describe how the project meets the County's guidelines.

This project is consistent with the County and Federal U.S. Treasury guidelines for the use of ARPA funds. This falls under the Public Safety category as it is equipment for Law Enforcement. This is a one-time purchase with no additional costs needed after purchase. Christiana Borough is prepared to fund 20% of this project with no additional administrative, interest, fees or other costs.

Why should this be a priority and how will it help the County? Also, if this application is for more than one project, please identify each one, provide information, and rank them in the order of priority.

The Christiana Borough Police Department provides police services to Christiana Borough. This funding would pay for the vehicle and cover all equipment including safety equipment, cameras, and computers. Most importantly, having a reliable vehicle will allow the department to respond to emergencies in a timely matter.

Will this project require ongoing expense (maintenance, updates) or frequent replacement? Are expenses already incurred, if so, can they be reduced through this project?

As with any vehicle, ongoing maintenance is required due to normal wear and tear. Christiana Borough is responsible for the maintenance of police vehicles. This money is provided from the General Fund.

The purchase of a new vehicle will replace a 2007 Crown Victoria. Replacement of an aging car will eliminate the costs associated with an older vehicle. Being that Christiana Borough is a small borough with limited tax revenue, a new vehicle would last for approximately 10 years, if not more.

Project Timeline – start to finish, and when funding will be needed.

The project would be completed as soon as possible depending on the availability of a vehicle and necessary equipment.
