How was the cost derived?	<b>Total amount requested: \$300,666.65</b> : Cost is for new Motorola radios already purchased (invoice attached), Ballistic Shields for patrol vehicles, New Life Saving Modern AED's for patrol vehicles, Tracs Software/printers for vehicles-officer safety, New Non-Lethal Shotguns for patrol vehicles, Datamaster Intoxilyzer 9000 DUI equipment, New modern Tasers and EOTECH Rifle sights for patrol rifles (School Safety), New Patrol Truck (invoice pending), Watchguard Video in Patrol cars and Body worn Cameras and Premium Pay for workers during pandemic.

This project will greatly increase the safety of our schools and our wonderful children as well as protecting our residents to make a safer community.

By having modern equipment and tools, it will increase police response, safety and aid in officers being more visible to our community. The projects below are explained and ranked by priority:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Police Radios</b>-effective and reliable radio communication is key to officers' responses to emergency calls and safety of everyone in the community.(\$86,001.85, already purchased)</li> <li>2. <b>Watchguard BWC system</b>- In car video and body worn camera's that record all events during emergency calls and public interactions during a call. Increasing safety and accountability for the department.(\$54,503) (already purchased and installed)</li> <li>3. <b>Ballistic Shields</b>- To have Shields available in patrol units upon arrival of a school shooting/barricaded gunman situation and also equipping the SRO with Shields in the school-aids in faster response times. (\$12,240.00)</li> <li>4. <b>NEW AEDS</b>-Modern life saving AED's that are reliable and effective for saving lives. (\$12,291)</li> <li>5. <b>Tracs Software/Printer</b>- Installing a printer and software in patrol cars to save time, money and increase officer safety while on the roadway during a traffic stop.(\$8000)</li> <li>6. <b>DataMaster Intoxilizer 9000</b>- Provide Modern DUI equipment at station for DUI arrests.(\$9000)</li> <li>7. <b>Tasers</b>- Provide updated modern tasers to officers for their safety and safety of others (mental health) (\$12,655)</li> <li>8. <b>EoTech Rifle Sights</b>- Provide state of art rifle optics for AR-15 rifles for increased accuracy during shootouts (Schools) (\$17,311.80)</li> <li>9. <b>Non-Lethal Shotguns</b>-provide non-lethal alternatives for mental health cases involving violent offenders. (\$4690)</li> <li>10. <b>Police Patrol Truck</b>- replace older patrol vehicle (unsafe) with new patrol vehicle with safer equipment. (Invoice pending) (5 yr lease-\$45,974)</li> <li>11. <b>Premium Pay</b> for 19 workers during Pandemic-Officers, Staff had regular interactions with the public and risked health and safety during this time.(\$38,000) (19 x 2,000).</li> </ol>
