Lancaster County Controller Named Central Penn Business Journal Woman of Influence; Auditing Team Wins National Award from Government Financial Officers Association

Lancaster, PA – Lancaster County Controller Lisa Colón was named by the Central Penn Business Journal as one of the 2024 Women of Influence. The Controller’s Office also received an award from the Government Financial Officers Association (GFOA) for Outstanding Achievement in Popular Annual Financial Reporting.

The Women of Influence honors high-achieving women for their career accomplishments. These women are selected based on their professional experience, community involvement and commitment to mentoring. Controller Colón will be recognized at an awards ceremony and featured in the July issue of the Central Penn Business Journal. This is the first time that a member of the Controller’s Office has received this award.

The GFOA’s Award for Outstanding Achievement in Popular Annual Financial Reporting represents a significant achievement for the Controller’s Office and the auditing team. To be eligible, the office had to submit its popular annual financial report to GFOA for review and receive the Certificate of Achievement for the current fiscal year. Judges reviewed the report and found that Lancaster County’s was deserving of the award. This marks the first time Lancaster County has received this award.
